



Template call for volunteers

Dear friend,

The *[name of organisation]* has announced plans to stage a Reading of the Testimonies in *[name of venue]* on *[date]* to mark the 15th anniversary of the 100 day Rwandan Genocide.

We are hoping that people from across *[location of the event]* will gather in *[name of venue]* for a Reading of the Testimonies of 100 survivors of the Rwandan genocide from *[time of event]*. These testimonies, highlighting the personal stories of survivors, represent just a small proportion of the young survivors that SURF supports through IBUKA and its grassroots partners in Rwanda including AVEGA and Solace Ministries.

Reading of the Testimonies will be the first outdoor event to be held in *[location of the event]* to mark the anniversary of the genocide. By taking the commemoration into a public space, the event will convey to survivors in Rwanda that, people in *[location of the event]* remember the genocide, the survivors and the victims.

Volunteers will be needed on the day to keep an eye on the crowd and general security; to help look after speakers and manage the programme; to give out leaflets, to collect donations; to encourage people to sign the petition. Those interested can apply online through *[website address]*.

The event follows the success of the first Reading of the Testimonies staged in Trafalgar Square in London in 2004, which helped to secure £4 million funding from the British Government to support antiretroviral treatment for 2,500 women survivors raped during the genocide and deliberately infected with HIV and AIDS:
